






# PIPE CLAMP BENCH VISE


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These diagrams indicate the dimensions I used for my Paulk style work table with a 7" interior cavity and a 1/2" thick top plywood surface. Adjust as necessary to fit your work surface. If using 3/4" pipe clamps I would make the holes 1/2" lower on all surfaces and also make the front jaw 1" taller. Refer to the website article and video for instructions.





4 pieces of 3/4" plywood for front jaw. Drill 7/8" holes for 1/2" pipe clamps.



1 pieces of 3/4" plywood for rear jaw. Hole spacing is the same. Drill larger holes for clearance.
