



The left page is page 3, page 2 in the middle. Page 1 on the right. Cut the border off of page 2. Use the light from a window to stack the X alignment locations and tape the left side of page 2 on top of the right side of page 3. Stack the right side of page 2 on top of the left side of page 1. Pages are in the horizontal layout. Once the template is created, glue it or tape it to a 20" section of 2x6. If you have a jointer, removing the rounded edges of the 2x6 after cutting is recommended. If you don't have a jointer, use the table saw to remove the rounded edges before securing the template to the wood. No need to steal your kids stick glue, I used a few dabs of regular woodworking glue on the surface of the wood, smeared it lightly with my finger to make it thin and tacky, then stuck the template down. Add a heel cleat when done. Easy peasy.
